Staffed by professionals and trained volunteers, Camp MAGIC is free of charge. Each camper will be paired with a volunteer to provide companionship, support and supervision throughout all activities for the duration of the camp stay. Parents and caregivers are encouraged to attend.

Camp MAGIC exists to:

- Provide children with a safe place to express their grief
- Engage children in special activities to help normalize their feelings
- Help children experience a sense of togetherness with other children who have lost loved ones
- Promote communication between children and their parents regarding their loss, as well as to provide resources to parents
